

## INFORMATION FOR ADMITTED APPLICANTS

Dear applicants,  
thank you for your interest in studying at our faculty.

If you decide to enrol and study at our faculty, you need to attend the attendance registration on **2<sup>th</sup> September 2024** at **8:00** at the FEI STU in room **AB300**.

**It is not possible to enrol for studies by proxy.**

### Before enrolling:

All students are required to complete an e-form prior to enrolment. The login details for the application form "Return to the application form for studies at STU" have been sent to the e-mail address provided in the e-application form. In this application you will confirm your interest in studying at FEI STU. You will then be able to order one of the offered types of STU student ID card, pay for it, insert your photo and select compulsory elective courses

### You must bring:

1. ID card or passport
2. Residence card
3. **Statutory declaration about student's higher-education studies in the Slovak Republic** – (if you have not yet studied at STU please do not fill in the ID, as it will be generated only after the study has been established; the data on the completed bachelor's and engineering study are not to be given)
4. **Enrollment sheet**
  - **A certified copy of the diploma and the transcript of courses and grades obtained during the entire previous university study (only those who have not yet submitted them in paper form)** - of course, does not apply to FEI STU graduates from 2024.

### Recognition of subjects:

If you have already studied at STU or another HEI and want to have your courses recognised, fill in the application for recognition of completed courses and submit it together with the transcript of grades with your enrolment documents.

The Certificate of Studies will be issued after enrolment, at the earliest from **4<sup>th</sup> September 2024**.
